

NORTH SAGAMORE WATER DISTRICT MEETING
MINUTES FROM MONDAY, MARCH 6, 2017

The North Sagamore Water District Board of Water Commissioners meeting was held on Monday, March 6 at 4:00 pm at 14 Squanto Road, Sagamore Beach, MA. The meeting was called to order by Commissioner Melchionda at 4:06 pm.

The following individuals were present at the start of the meeting: Commissioner Mark Melchionda, Commissioner Mark Bergeron, Superintendent Matt Sawicki, Treasurer Maureen Fruci and Town of Sandwich Assessor Ed Childs. Chairperson Sala was not present.

TAX CLASSIFICATION HEARING – TOWN OF SANDWICH

Commissioner Melchionda introduced Ed Childs, Assessor for the town of Sandwich. Mr. Childs explained the process of the classification hearing. The Sandwich Board of Assessors recommends the District go with a factor of one for all classes of property, no residential exemption, no open space discount, and no small commercial exemption. Commissioner Bergeron made the motion to adopt a factor of one for FY17, no residential exemption, no open space discount, no small commercial exemption. Commissioner Melchionda seconded the motion. The motion was accepted.

ANY OLD/NEW BUSINESS THAT MAY LEGALLY COME BEFORE THE BOARD

Superintendent Sawicki informed the Board there were a couple of change orders for the Black Pond well project. The contractor brought in a generator for supplemental power and also recommended the column be replaced.

The Superintendent addressed the Board regarding the Beach Well Zone 1 map. DEP will come out at the end of the week to delineate Zone 1 and we will also have to delineate Zone 2. It may be necessary to send a letter from the Board to all the residents in Zone 1 regarding the storage of gasoline, fertilizer etc.

Commissioner Melchionda recommended changing the policy for the Superintendent's position regarding overtime or a salary increase. He requested it be included on the agenda for the next monthly meeting.

Commissioner Bergeron asked if there were any developments regarding the Fisher Lane irrigation. The Superintendent received the paperwork for the irrigation system and will meet with the property manager before the next meeting. He also told the Board there has been no response from the abutters to the Norris Road project regarding the meeting on March 16th.
